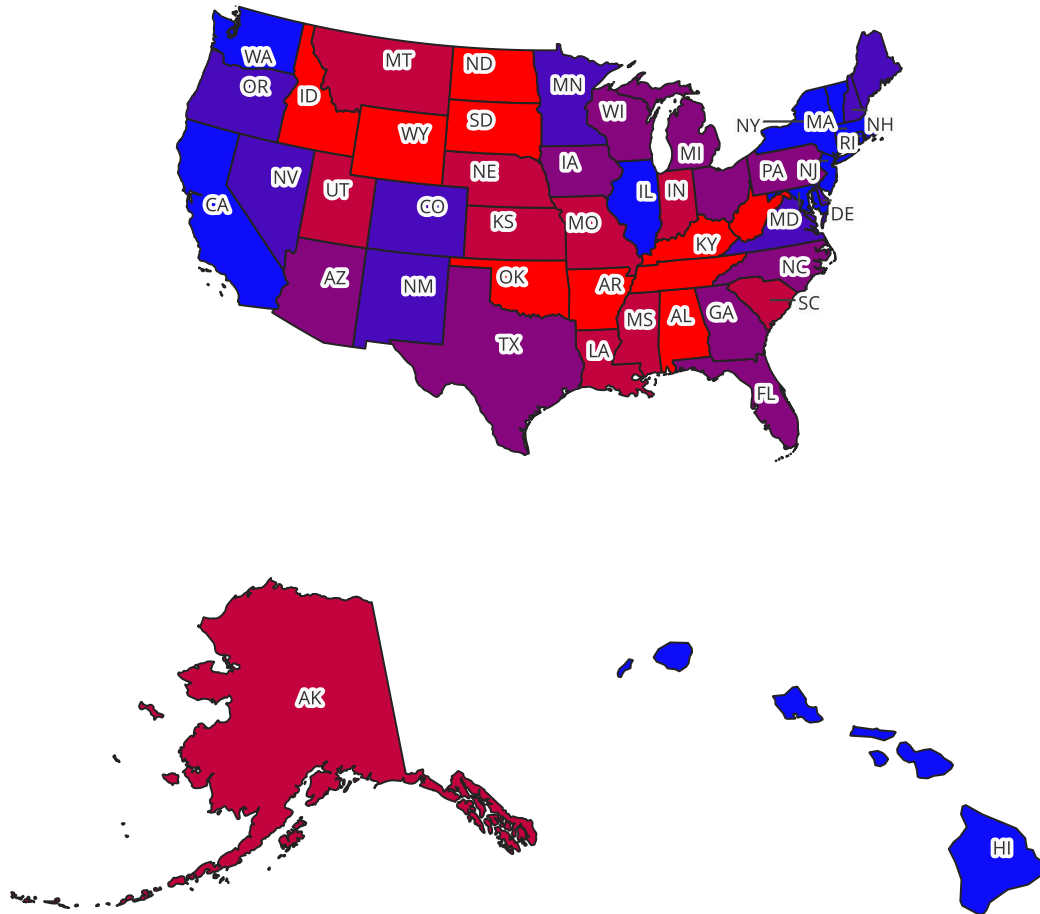


US 2016 Election Results



In the United States, the Democrat and Republican parties have a duopoly on federal politics. In an effort to see where major party voters are, each state was assigned a value representative of the percentage of Trump voters out of the pool of Trump and Clinton voters. It should be noted that the ranges are significantly shifted towards the lower end. For example, the District of Columbia only showed a 4.3% major party turnout in favor of Trump. On the contrary the highest major party turnout in favor of Trump was 75.7, not nearly as extreme.
